# Player Rates by level for 2022-23

Minis Mites- No Change Mites- \$475 No Change Squirts- \$635 (+\$50) Peewees- \$775 (+\$50) Bantams- \$875 (+\$50) includes 2.5 hrs of practice per week

Increase the volunteer check to \$200 to ensure people are contributing to CHA events

> Impact- <mark>\$0</mark> but more Tournament, help and participation

### Rationale-

This will help ensure our tournaments and rink are fully supported with events and needs throughout the season.

Raised ref rates to ensure we are able to cover games via a travel stipend.

#### Impact-

Increases reflected in rate adjustments of + \$25 per ref per day as budgeted

## Rationale-

CHA was the lowest paying in the area for "hard to find" officials. The availability of refs continues to be a HUGE challenge!

Hold a "SCRIP Program Night" AND post a video while Continue putting 100% back to players accounts on all ECard SCRIP purchases to encourage usage by Family Members at NO COST.

### Impact-

Provide an opportunity for members to utilize this program to make hockey more affordable year round Rationale-The feedback provided from the survey **CONTINUES** to show a need for this type of meeting to help keep hockey affordable The Impact of these changes based on estimated **Player numbers** in 22-23 results in the following:
